## WHO WE ARE

This workshop aims to open a space for dialogue with youth about their rights and responsibilities online (thinking about what violence and discrimination look like in this context), and to educate youth about the laws that govern criminal harassment and the sharing of images online.

## CURRICULUM

This workshop meets PLOs for Health & Career Education 8 & 9, Planning 10, & Social Justice 12.

## LENGTH & COST

The full workshop is 2.5 hours and can be offered over 1, 2, or 3 sessions. If you have booked a "No Means No" workshop, "TrendShift" can be added onto the end, in which case it requires only 1.5 hours. We ask for a \$100 honorarium (on a sliding scale) to help cover the costs of the workshop; we are committed to making this workshop accessible to all audiences and are happy to discuss an arrangement that will work for your group.
